

Ring Size Guide

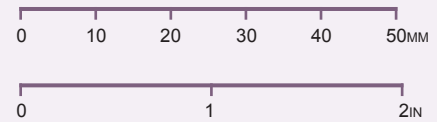


Before You Start...

Before using this guide, please make sure that your print out is the correct size

1. In your printer settings, make sure page scaling is set to 'None'.
2. Once printed, measure the bar on the right with a ruler to make sure it's exactly 50mm or 2 inches long.
3. If measurement is inaccurate, check your printer settings and repeat these directions.

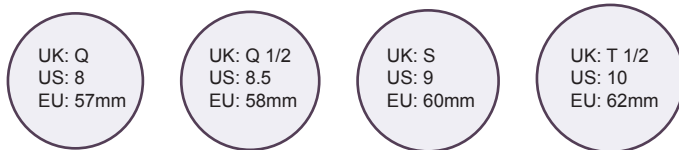

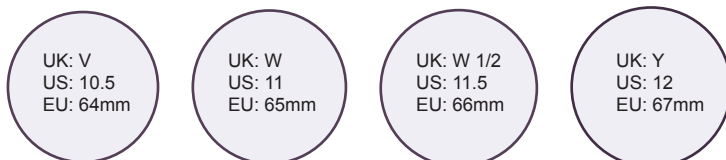
The Circle Test

Measure an existing ring to double check your size.

1. Place the ring over one of the circles.
2. Carefully line it up and look at the **inside edge** of the ring, you should see all of the **dark purple edge** of the circle and no white paper. Make sure you look directly down over the ring.
3. Double check the size by checking the circles either side. You should find that one is too small (where you can't see all of the dark purple circle) and one is too big (you can see the white of the paper).
4. If you are inbetween sizes we would recommend that you round up or down to the closest size. For example, if you are a Size R, the closest size would be a Q 1/2, as this is only half a size difference. The Size S is a full size bigger and is likely to be too big, unless you like your rings to fit loosely

The Paper Test

1. Carefully cut out the ring sizer below.
2. Gently fold the end along the dotted line and cut a small slit as indicated (the dark purple line), then unfold.
3. You may want to put a little tape just above the slit (the shaded area) to prevent it ripping when you use it.
4. Place the end of the ring sizer through the slit to make a loop.
5. Slide the sizer over your finger and pull through the slit until it fits snug.
6. Check that it fits comfortably and remember that you will have to get the ring over your knuckle.
7. Your ring size is shown by the letter on the line shown through the slit. If you are inbetween letters, you are a half size.
